



Charlotte Observer Endorses Robin Anderson

Charlotte – Today the Charlotte Observer Endorsed Robin Anderson in her campaign for Commissioner of Labor.

"I am honored by this endorsement. The Charlotte Observer's recent investigation into the deplorable working conditions at certain poultry processing plants and the current Commissioner of Labor's lack of response exposed just how badly a new voice is needed for working families in North Carolina."

The Observer stressed that the North Carolina Department of Labor requires a change of perspective. The Observer described Anderson as "passionate about worker safety" with the ability to get things done. The paper went on to say, "We believe that kind of passion is needed to reform the labor department. We recommend Robin Anderson."
